## The China Science & Technology Museum

is an important place of popular science education in China. Its aim is to pass knowledge of science and technology among the public, and help increase the scientific and cultural literacy of all citizens. The museum covers an area of 400,000 square meters, of which 16,000 square metres is for its main 3 exhibition halls. Hall. A exhibits ancient Chinese technology & astronomy, the compass, gunpowder, bronze smelting & casting, papermaking and printing. Hall. B has over 300 collections from aeronautics, astronautics, energy, communications, material science & mechanics, information technology, life science and environmental science. Hall. C is one of the museum's major attractions and also one of the largest Astro-vision theatres in the world.

## China National Children's Centre

Set up in 1982, the **China National Children's Centre** is a non-profit organization for teenagers after-school education at national level. It works as a window for the international inter-course of China children's work. The basic aim of CNCC is 'Everything for Children'. It is focused on the children from 0-18 years old, and their parents/teachers. As a hub for after-school education, the CNCC sponsor various educational activities focused around many themes, and organizes training courses for different interest groups in art, sports, science, language etc, in order to broaden children's knowledge, develop their personality, raise their competence and grow up healthily.
